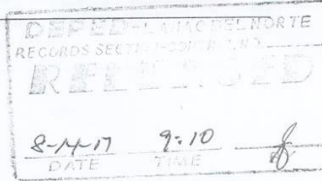

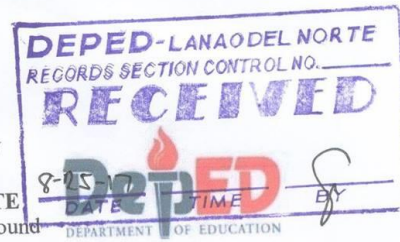
1. The 2017 Division Schools Press Conference will be held on August 29-31, 2017 at Binuni-Demologan National High School, Bacolod, Lanao del Norte.
2. Anchored on the theme "Strengthening Freedom of Information through Campus Journalism", this year's DSPC aims to:
 - a. provide pupils and coaches deeper awareness and understanding on their role in promoting good governance and transparency through freedom of information.
 - b. enhance writing competencies of campus journalists through friendly individual and group competitions.
 - c. identify best writers and radio broadcasters who will compete during the Regional Schools Press Conference.

3. School Principals are advised to make necessary arrangements so as not to disrupt classes with the absence of the school paper advisers participating the 2017 DSPC.
4. Registration fee for each participant including each school paper adviser is One Hundred Fifty pesos (Php 150.00) to defray expenses such as honoraria and travel of Resource Speakers and facilitators, prizes and awards, certificates, venue rental, sound system rental, food and accommodation and other expenses incurred during the activity.
5. Enhancement training will follow on September 1 – 3, 2017, after the press conference. This is to allow this division's qualifiers to the Regional Schools Press Conference to learn more journalistic reporting techniques from experts who shall have served as DSPC judges.
6. Senior High School learners are included as participants/contestants in said confab.
7. Each participating school should submit 2 copies of their **20-page school paper** (please use A4 size bondpaper for easy revision).
8. Registration, travel and food allowance of school paper advisers and campus journalists participating said event shall be charged against local / MOE/school paper funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing policies, rules and regulations.
9. School Paper Advisers who plan to stay overnight at the venue should make arrangements with the School Principal in advance.
10. The host schools are requested to prepare the opening program, hall, contest rooms and sleeping quarters of the Resource Speakers and of some participants.
11. Wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.

4. Contest Guidelines shall be based from DepEd Order No. 47 s. 2010 and DepEd Memorandum No. 216 s. 2016.
5. School Paper Advisers who plan to stay overnight at the host school must inform Dr. Pablo B. Nisnisan via CP No. 09177074255 for necessary arrangements on accommodation and food catering as there is no food house nearby.
6. There will no longer be a lecture before the contest as it is expected that each competing school shall have already conducted the school-level press conference for the selection of DSPC contestants.
7. School Paper Advisers are required to submit documents for the Division Search for Outstanding School Paper Adviser.
